Season of Creation 2022

'Faith is not a light which scatters all our darkness, but a lamp which guides our steps in the night and suffices for the journey.' It therefore means daring to look at the crisis from another perspective: the perspective of God. Looking at our planet from the perspective of the Creator permits us to see things from beyond, as it were.

This pastoral letter is addressed in a particular way to people of faith in the Archdiocese of Dublin. It is a word of encouragement and a call to action in the face of something that threatens every aspect of our lives today and into the future. It asks how we follow Jesus in this unprecedented crisis. How do we live our faith in this new time? How do we pray, and what difference does prayer make? What is God saying to the world? What is the Spirit saying to the churches? (see Rev 3:22). As your bishop, I wish to explore these and other questions with you.
