October 3, was the feast of **Blessed Columba Marmion**, a **Dublin diocesan priest** who became Benedictine Abbot of Maredsous in Belgium. This icon of Blessed Columba was commissioned by Dundrum Parish in 2018 – the recently ordained Fr Marmion served as curate there in 1880. The icon was blessed in September



2018 by Archbishop Martin. The icon depicts six church buildings that relate to his life – Baptism (St Paul's), Ordination (St Agata's, Rome), Holy Cross Church, Dundrum (Curate), Clonliffe College (Lecturer), Maredsous and St Peter's (Beatification/Vatican II). The images of the Theotokos and Holy Trinity relate to his teaching and spirituality. The quote from scripture, "For me, to live is Christ", is a summary of his life and teaching.

St Gerard Majella was born on April 6, 1726 in Muro, Italy. He was the son of a tailor who died when Gerard was 12, leaving the family in poverty. Gerard tried to join the Capuchin order but was denied because of his ill health. He was later accepted as a Redemptorist brother serving the Redemptorist congregation as gardener, tailor, fundraiser, peacemaker and spiritual adviser. His intercession is requested for children

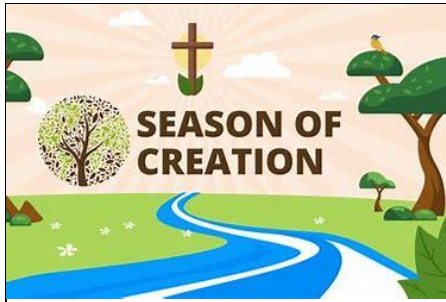
