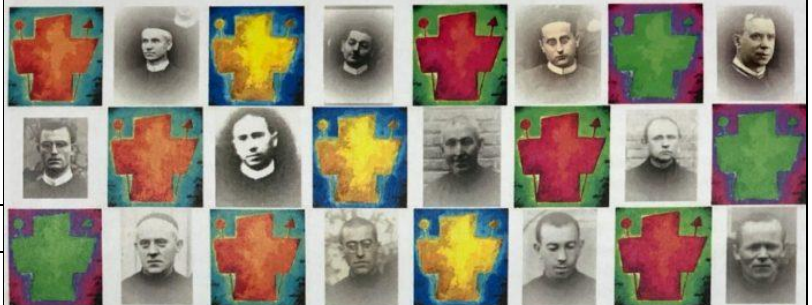

The events will end with a Eucharist on Sunday the 23rd, at 12:00 noon, presided over by Fr. General. In all, twenty Redemptorists were martyred in the religious persecution of 1936-39.
