November Altar of Remembrance



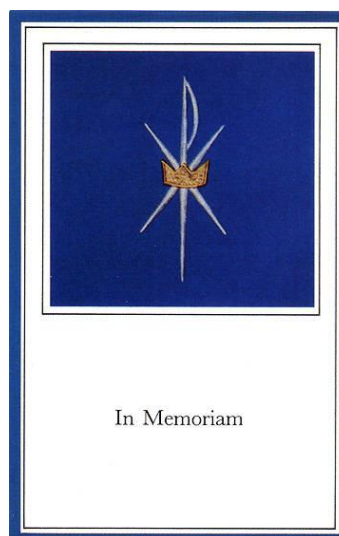

November Lists of the Dead & Envelopes

We ask you to write out the names of the deceased people you want remembered, return the envelope to the Church and we will include their names in all of the masses and prayers we celebrate during the month of November.

While these mass is for all deceased parishioners and relatives of parishioners, we will extend a special invitation to all families in the parish who have been bereaved since last November to come to this mass.

This Sunday, November 13, marks the 6th Annual World Day of the Poor. The theme for this day is *For your sakes Christ became poor* (2 Cor 8:9). With these words, the Apostle Paul addresses the first Christians of Corinth to encourage their efforts to show solidarity with their brothers and sisters in need. In his message for 2022, Pope Francis has emphasised a faith leading to action. He particularly highlights that need for our world to be in solidarity with those marginalised because of forced migration.
