**Venue:** probably Pastoral Centre at Our Lady of Assumption Parish, Ballyfermot.

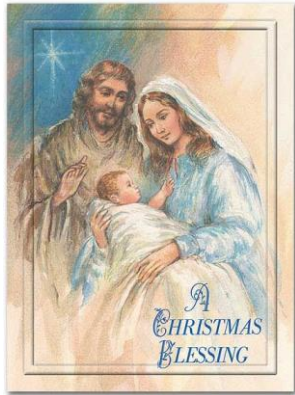
