Sunday 29th October, 2023 Time: 2pm Meeting at the shrine of Matt Talbot in Our Lady of Lourdes Church on Sean MacDermott Street, Dublin,1 On the tour we visit the nearby Albrough Court off Portland Row where Matt was born in 1856. We stop near O'Meara's Pub (today's Cusack's Pub on the North Strand Road) where Matt had his last drink. We visit Upper Rutland Street (today's Sean O'Casey Avenue) where he lived. We visit Granby Lane where he died on his way to mass on Trinity Sunday, June 7th 1925. Come along. All welcome.

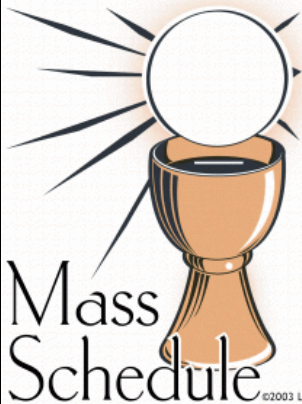
