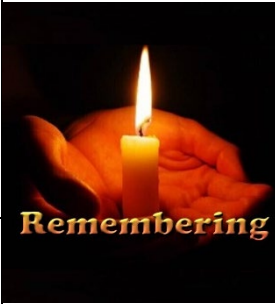
Pope Francis' Invitation

“The possible widening of the conflict is disturbing, while so many war fronts are already open in the world. May weapons fall silent! Let us heed the cry for peace of populations, of the people, of the children! Brothers and

sisters, war does not solve any problem: it sows only death and destruction, ferments hate and proliferates revenge. War cancels out the future. I urge believers to take just one side in this conflict: that of peace. But not with words – with prayer, with total dedication.

photos or memorial cards of your beloved who are deceased and leave them on the altar for the month of November. It is another way of remembering our departed beloved ones. Maybe you could be an ambassador by letting other people know who mightn't know about this way of remembering the dead and you might kindly bring their remembrance photo/memorial card along for them.



November 9th is the birthday of the founding of the Congregation of the Most Holy Redeemer (Redemptorists). The Congregation numbered less than 10 priests and brothers

on this day in 1732. Alphonsus was the oldest at the age of 36. Each man was consumed with **zeal for the poor**, especially those living in the remote hill country surrounding Scala, on the outskirts of Naples. The most abandoned were the shepherd people who had little knowledge of the Gospel; here Alphonsus and companions began their mission. **Alphonsus and his companions were young and few in number, yet God called them to bring the Gospel to those in most need.**

Prisoners' Sunday (*which is today*) is a national day of prayer and action for prisoners and their dependants as marked by the Catholic Church. It is a day to direct our thoughts and prayers to prisoners, their families and children. Prisoners' Sunday is the time to reflect on how we as individuals, as a Church and as a community are serving those affected by imprisonment. Prisoners' families, prisoners and people with previous convictions often find themselves on the margins of society due to the social stigma associated with imprisonment. But the gospel of Matthew 25: 36 reminds us of our duties towards them: **"I was in prison and you came to see me."**
