11 FEBRUARY 2026

Pope Leo XIV has chosen the theme for the 34th World Day of the

Sick, (Feb 11) **“The compassion of the Samaritan: loving by bearing the pain of the other”**. The theme, focusing on the Gospel figure of the Good Samaritan who shows love by caring for the suffering man who fell into the hands of thieves, highlights this aspect of love of neighbour: love needs concrete gestures of closeness, through which we enter into the suffering of others, those who are ill, especially those who at the same time experience poverty, isolation, and loneliness . The World Day of the Sick, established by St. John Paul II in 1992, is a privileged moment of prayer, spiritual closeness, and reflection for the entire Church and for civil society, who are all called to recognize the face of Christ in our sick and vulnerable brothers and sisters.
