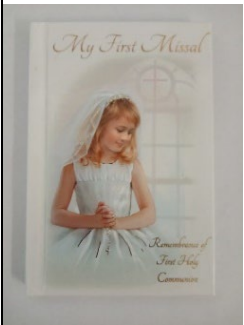
of joy but alongside people in their struggles. In a time when the Church faces
