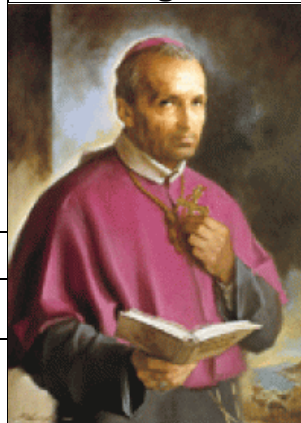

Friday, August 1st was the feast day of Saint Alphonsus Liguori.

He was born in Marianella near Naples, Italy on September 27, 1696. On November 9, 1732, Alphonsus founded the Congregation of the Most

Holy Redeemer, popularly known as the Redemptorists, to follow the example of Jesus Christ announcing the Good News to the poor and the most abandoned. He died in Paganì on August 1, 1787. He was canonized in 1839, proclaimed a Doctor of the Church in 1871 and Patron of Confessors & Moralists in 1950.

On Friday, last the the Redemptorists Provinces of Dublin, St. Clements, London, and Vienna-Münich united to form a new Federation. Fr General launched this new arrangement at a Mass in Limerick City.
